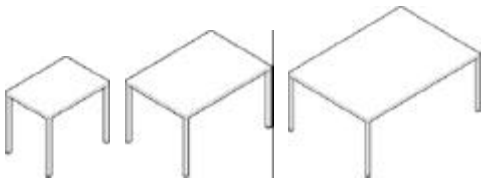


Fig. The width of the small table becomes the length of the next largest format.

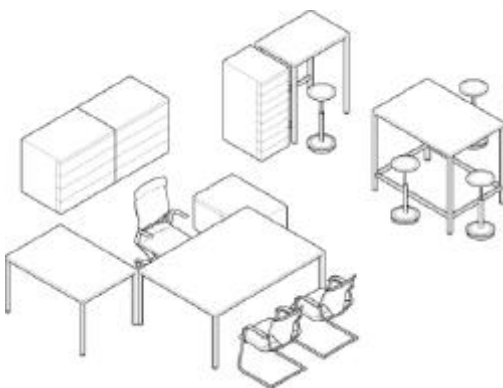
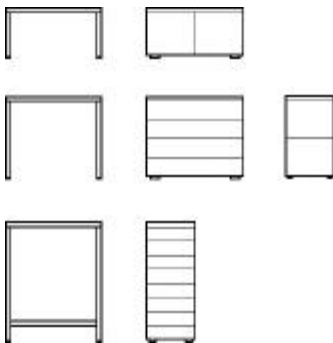


Fig. Low, sitting and standing height open up three third dimensions for innovative utilization concepts for office and conference interiors.

One set of proportions, one principle, three third dimensions

The proportions of the table surfaces and storage surfaces follow the DIN A formula of $A : B = A : (A \times 1.414)$. And as paper formats in the office determine most storage principles, DIN A paper sizes have been used: the large table (1/1 table) is achieved by doubling the DIN A0 format (1680 x 1188 mm). The 1/2 table (DIN A0 = 1188 x 840 mm) and 1/4 table (DIN A1 = 840 x 594 mm) are the result of halving the surfaces. This principle is likewise applied to the storage units, called Volumina: 1/4 Volumina (DIN A1) and 1/8 Volumina (DIN A2 = 420 x 594 mm). As conference and office interiors are not defined solely in terms of surfaces, DinA elements are available in three functional heights: low, sitting and standing height (440, 730, 1050 mm).

Ingenious simplicity

Although the concept seems simple, the scope which this very simplicity allows, is quite complex and versatile. Each format is derived by doubling the next one down ($1 = 2 = 4$), and tables and Volumina can be extended and combined as required. The coherence of form and surfaces creates harmonious spatial cross references and structures, regardless as to how they are configured.

There is also wide scope for flexible application of the functional heights: the low height is, for example, not only suitable as a side table and a storage surface, but it can also serve as a stool.

Less is more: less material but high quality

Materials have been selected to blend with the concept of the range: table tops and Volumina comprise MDF panel, through-dyed in the colour black-grey, which is mitre jointed in true carpentry tradition. Drawers have no visible handles, and open and close with finger pressure. This gives the elements a solid, monolithic elegance, when free standing or grouped.

The tables legs are screw-fitted to a concealed steel underframe. They are in matt stainless steel, with a surface finish that is shot blasted in two stages with glass beads and steel balls.

The interior of the Volumina also reveal coherence down to the very last detail: moulded accessories trays, practical laptop shelves, stainless steel runners for the files drawers and drawers that open and close with finger pressure underline the excellent quality of the range. All drawers lock as a central locking system and are with interlock.

Accessories

An optional, black polyester storage net, attached to the underframe, is available for tables. Other options include modesty panels with transparent, stretch fabric and cable management elements, which may be retrofitted.

Prices and delivery periods

Wilkhahn is offering the DinA tables in all formats and heights at a standard price of EUR 750 (+ VAT). Prices of the highly sophisticatedly manufactured Volumina start at EUR 2,015 (+ VAT). Delivery periods are 4-6 weeks after receipt of order.
